Resounding Success of IFEX 2025



The biggest confluence of Industry Professionals from All Across the Country: IFEX 2025 stood out not only among IIF events but across the entire Indian foundry sector. As the largest gathering of professionals, businesses, and industry enthusiasts, it reinforced its position as a premier hub for networking, knowledge exchange, and business growth.

More Exhibitors, More Brands, Wide Exposure: With **266 exhibitors participating, IFEX 2025** hosted a great number of exhibitors in its history. This diversity and volume of exhibitors allowed visitors to explore a wide array of products, technologies, and services, fostering an environment rich in innovation and collaboration.

Massive Area Occupied at the Two Halls at Biswa Bangla Mela Prangan: The event spread over a net area of 15,000 square meters exceeding from 13,598 square meters in the last edition, the largest footprint for any IFEX to date. This expansive space accommodated numerous exhibitors and installations, facilitating a comprehensive showcase of the industry's capabilities and innovations.



Milestones Achieved:

Highest Number of Visitors: The event attracted **21,265 visitors**, marking the highest attendance in IFEX history. This significant turnout underscores the event's appeal and relevance to a wide audience, including industry professionals, businesses, and enthusiasts eager to stay abreast of the latest trends and technologies.

Live Robotics Demo by DiFACTO: For the first time in Kolkata, The Institute of Indian Foundrymen (IIF), in collaboration with DiFACTO Robotics and Automation, presented a Live Robotics & Automation Demonstration in Hall B at IFEX 2025. The showcase featured cutting-edge technologies, including industrial robots, robotic grinding & fettling, random bin picking with a 3D vision system, collaborative robots, and autonomous mobile robots (AMRs). Visitors had the opportunity to witness live demonstrations, interact with industry experts, and explore groundbreaking innovations transforming the foundry sector. The Robotics & Automation Symposium provided valuable insights into the latest advancements, fostering knowledge exchange and industry growth.

IFEX 2025 -Visitor Analysis

IFEX 2025 witnessed a remarkable surge in visitor turnout compared to the previous edition, reflecting its growing prominence in the foundry industry. This year, the exhibition recorded a total footfall of 21,265 visitors, a significant increase from the 12,501 visitors in the previous edition. Similarly, total registrations saw an impressive rise, **reaching 40,546 compared to 23,509 last year**. 

Inauguration Ceremony

It served as a dynamic platform for **industry leaders, manufacturers, suppliers, and technology providers** to explore new business opportunities and showcase the latest innovations in foundry technology.

Held concurrently with the **73rd Indian Foundry Congress**, IFEX 2025 was a **confluence of ideas**, that brought together **renowned technologists, policymakers, investors, and industry veterans** to discuss emerging trends, challenges, and opportunities shaping the future of the foundry sector.





The 73rd version of the Indian Foundry Congress (IFC), the flagship event of the Indian Foundry Industry, has been inaugurated here in Kolkata, the City of Joy, today, February 9, 2025, at Biswa Bangla Mela Prangan, the venue of the mega event organised by The Institute of Indian Foundrymen (IIF). Eastern Region is the host region of the IFC. IFCX 2025, the largest foundry exhibition in India, held concurrently with the 73rd IFC.

The twin mega event will continue till Feb 11, 2025. Various experts from around the world contributed their insights, covering a broad spectrum of topics relevant to the metallurgy and foundry industry. Throughout the conference, attendees had the opportunity to participate in specialised tracks focused on innovation in foundry technology, critical sustainability practices, quality assurance in manufacturing, and the latest advancements in materials science.





Inaugural Function

The Chief Guest, Padma Bhushan Babasaheb N Kalyani, MD of Bharat Forge, shared nostalgic memories of his visits to Kolkata in the 1970s. He spoke passionately about how "Sonar Bangla" is emerging as a hub of metallurgical activity, reviving West Bengal's former glory. Highlighting current challenges, he underscored four pivotal areas of focus: artificial intelligence, the transition from fossil fuels to renewable energy, advancements in bioengineering and genetic technologies, and effective supply chain management. Both he and his wife received heartfelt recognition and awards for their contributions, with the coveted leadership award being presented to him. Mr. Om Prakash Jalan, Managing Director, Bengal Energy Limited, was the Guest of honour. Mr. Vijay S Beriwal, Chairman, Organising Committee, 73rd IFC, briefed on IIF in the development of the Industry. India is the 2nd largest producer of castings in the world. Eastern India is the largest supplier of sanitary castings in the country.

Mr. Navneet Agarwal, President, IIF, in his address said that the foundry industry in Eastern India is growing at a rapid rate. The foundry industry, the



basic manufacturing sector, is eager to support the government's campaign of Viksit Bharat. He informed that a huge investment is expected to be pumped into Bengal's foundry industry. He further said that MSME foundries need to be supported by the government in several ways. Mr Ravi Sehgal, Chairman, IFEX 2025 in his address mentioned that yesterday's celebration of IIF's 75th year was a grand function. Mr Baba Kalyani's presence in the function was very motivative. He said, foundry industry in the Eastern Region including Bengal has changed remarkably. The industry here is developing very fast. IFEX 2025 is showcasing the present scenario of the industry. Following this, Mr. Sudip Sarkar shared remarkable statistics about IFC 2025 and IFEX. He proudly announced an impressive turnout, with 6,399 visitors from the foundry

sector, along with 4,018 equipment and machine manufacturers, 5,013 materials suppliers, and 4,000 service providers, plus an additional 700 participants from other categories. Dr. Shashi Panja, the Hon'ble Chief Guest at the IFC 73 Congress and Minister of Women and Child Development, Social Welfare, and Industry and Commerce in West Bengal, expressed her appreciation towards the organizing committee for their outstanding arrangements. During her address, she encouraged attendees to provide recommendations for improving state operations. Additionally, she motivated industrialists to consider establishing industries in Bengal, highlighting the opportunities and potential within the region. Her presence underscored the government's commitment to fostering industrial growth and social welfare in the state. The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Pradeep Kumar Madhogaria, Co-Chairman of the IFC. This was followed by an exciting book launch for IFEX 2025, culminating in a celebratory balloon release led by Executive Director Dr. Abhishikta Roychowdhury.


